Tom Kerr, Editor, Racing Post	TK discussed the return to racing behind closed doors and the relaunch of the newspaper edition of the Racing Post (RP). Jamie Hart, Tote Product Director	The meeting discussed concerns with the operation of the Tote and issues for bettors such as value in the markets. JH explained the competitive betting market in the UK and noted the differences in the Tote in international jurisdictions. JH discussed the entry points for the Tote pool and the impact of betting on the placepot. Betting shops had been decimated by the lockdown and were not as busy since reopening. This was likely to be as a consequence of an increase in internet betting during that time. JH emphasised the importance of engaging with bettors, and the value of the various bets offered by the Tote.
